

TRANSCRIPT COURSE CODES TO ENSURE ACCURATE A-G REPORTING

If a student has a course from another school or a college that will meet an A-G or a high school graduation requirement use the following codes to ensure these courses are included in reports.

- **Make sure to use the school code from where the credit was earned**
- **Make sure to include a header**
- **Use the Special Title to record the actual course title as it appears on the other school's transcript**
- **Only transferable college course will be entered (for Merced College that is courses from 1-49. Can have a letter like 01A but not just a letter like Math A)**
- **A semester college course counts as a year/10 credits for high school transcript**
